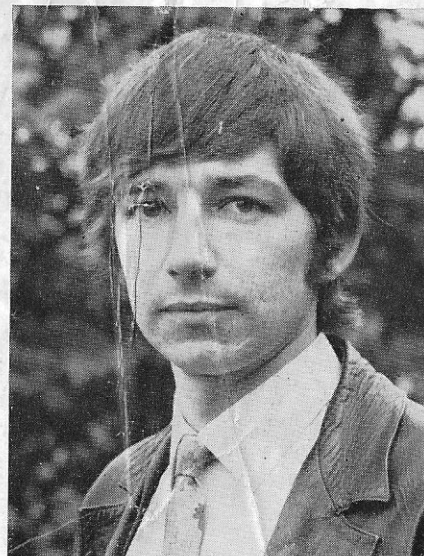

A Personal Message from the Labour Candidates

To the Electors of Desborough

Dear Elector,

Having been nominated for this by-election by the Desborough Local Labour Party may we take this opportunity of sending you our compliments and respectfully requesting your support.

Both of us were born and have resided in Desborough all our lives and we are keenly interested in the affairs and well-being of the town.

At the present time planning permission has been granted or is being sought for over 350 additional dwellings and whilst welcoming this we note with growing apprehension no proportionate increase in the amenities, especially in the field of education.

We are concerned that the Desborough Youth Centre which was partly paid for by the inhabitants of the town is not being used for the manner in which it was intended and we are prepared to take positive action in calling for a meeting of all interested parties to discuss the future of this project, as we feel that whilst it is desirable to have a flourishing Youth Centre it should also be possible to allow this building to be used to the benefit of our elderly citizens on the lines of a Community Centre.

As parents we are concerned that adequate road safety measures are taken upon the completion of the re-aligned A6 which is shortly to commence and which will be an extremely fast road and on which the volume of traffic is increasing.

We shall press for early action to be taken to improve the east side of High Street with its junction with Paddock Lane and the early acquisition of older properties to enable modern development to take place in this area.

We both feel passionately that a Councillor should be a friend and helper to all whom he is elected to serve, and if successful we promise to give your problems our best attention at all times, and intend to hold regular surgeries in order to re-create greater public participation in the town affairs.
